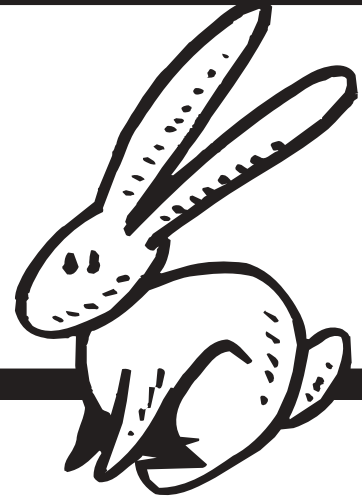

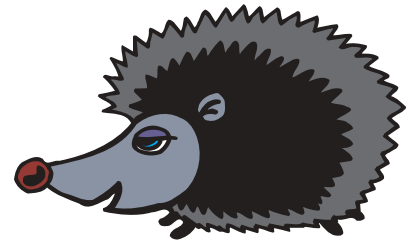

Paddler's Prefer:

Kayaking Lingo. When Deiter and Clark are teaching kayaking this summer impress them with how well you know names of the many terms & different maneuvers in kayaking. It may earn you some extra points towards your emblem!

"Boulder Garden" Rapids filled with large rocks.

"Curlers" Waves that curl at top and break partway on the upstream face.

"Eddy" Calm water downstream.

"Eddy-Hop" Moving from one eddy to another.

"Ender" A paddler intentionally standing his kayak on end in a hole or large wave. Looks very cool.

"Funny-Water" Exploding waves, whirlpools, or eddy fences in high water.

"Hair-Boating" Paddling difficult or dangerous rapids.

"Hydraulic" Water flows the wrong way upstream - often called a Keeper or Hole due to risk of getting caught in it.

"Pop-Up" Like an ender, but not quite vertical.

"Rooster Tail" Water spewing upward after hitting an obstacle.

"Sluice" Narrow channel in a rapid.

"Squirt" To place bow or stern under the water surface to make dramatic kayak movements.

"Surf" To play in the rapids by riding the upstream face of a wave.

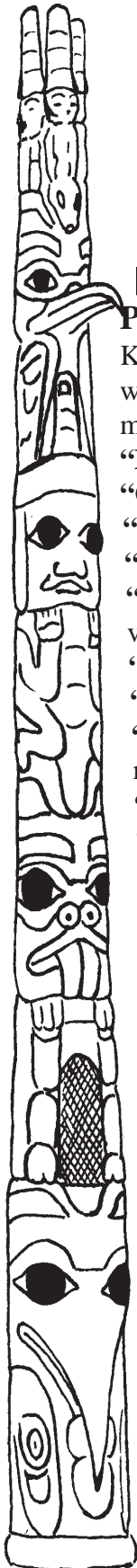
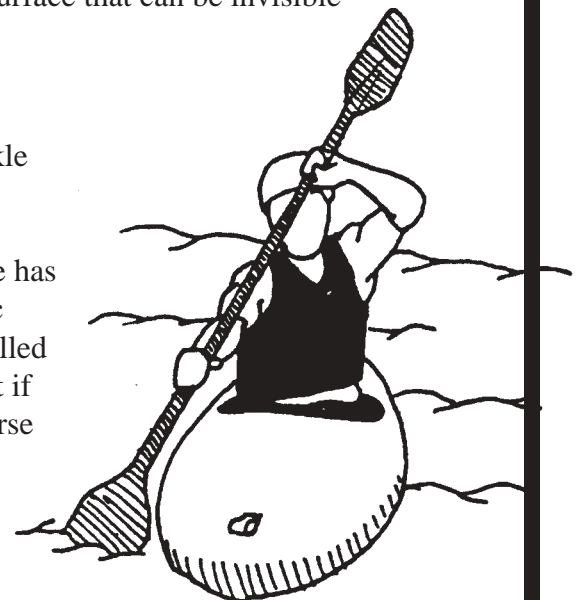
"Tongue" Smooth water in the shape of a "V" that is usually the safest route between two obstacles.

"Undercut" An eroded ledge from fast water under surface that can be invisible

CAROL'S CULINARY FUNSTERS CORNER Potato Pizza

2 lbs. russet potatoes
1/4 cu. virgin olive oil
salt to taste
2 tbs. toasted bread crumbs
1/4 lb. shredded smoked mozzarella
1/4 cu. grated Pecorino Romano cheese
2 medium tomatoes, seeded and diced
1 tsp. dried oregano

Boil the potatoes in salted water to cover until tender. Drain, when cool enough to handle, peel them. Put potatoes thru a ricer. Add 3 tbs. of the olive oil and salt to taste. Very lightly grease the pan with oil. Sprinkle with the bread crumbs. Spread the potato mixture over the pan to form a thin crust that is slightly thicker at the edges. Distribute the smoked mozzarella and sprinkle with the grated cheeses, tomato, and oregano. Drizzle with the remaining olive oil. Bake at 450 degrees for 20 minutes, or until the crust is golden.
